

- Clinical social work is a specialty practice area of social work which focuses on the assessment, diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of mental illness, emotional, and other behavioral disturbances.
- Individual, group and family therapy are common treatment modalities.
- Clinical social workers perform services in a variety of settings including private practice, hospitals, community mental health, primary care, and agencies.
- The knowledge base of clinical social work includes theories of biological, psychological and social development, diversity and cultural competency, interpersonal relationships, family and group dynamics, mental disorders, addictions, impacts of illness, trauma or injury and the effects of the physical, social and cultural environment. TASK FOR STUDENTS


- Under the supervision of the teachers, students should prepare a seminar paper of 3 A4 pages with relevant literature sources and current legislation.

SLNIEČKO = little sun

- Non-profit organization center "Slniečko" provides services to abused, mistreated and neglected children, victims of domestic violence, victims of sexual assaults and rape and also helps to tackle this issue effectively and in a comprehensive way in terms of securing and protection of fundamental human rights and freedoms.
- Safe Women's House is one of the few facilities in Slovakia that meets the Council of Europe's minimum standards for providing services to women experiencing violence and their children. It is a 24-hour accessible professional help service. Women and mothers with children are kept in the Safe House for the time necessary for crisis intervention. They provide them with protection and support, usually for 3 6 months.

- Association STORM was established in 2002. The association dedicates with the prevention of risky behavior of different target groups at the ground of low-threshold principles and in the terms of philosophy of Harm Reduction.
- The association STORM is one and only accredited subject of Ministry of labor, social affairs and family of Slovak republic in this area which works in three towns.
- primary prevention in non-organized groups of children and youth in Nitra, secondary prevention of drug addiction in the form of social street work with drug users and with people which works in the sexbusiness in Nitra, Trnava, and surrounding.

- is the point of contact for all foreigners arriving and living in Nitra
- Nitra is the city with the second highest number of refugees from Ukraine
- In the Nitra region, more than 15 thousand Ukrainians have been granted the status of refugees
- In 2022, the City Council approved the signing of a Memorandum of Cooperation between UNICEF and the City of Nitra.
- They provide information and advisory, assistance and legal services to foreigners affected by the armed conflict in Ukraine. At the same time, they serve as a safe place for everyone who needs help and information in the current situation.


